

How to fix a network printer that quit working (Zebra Label Printer)

Microsoft updates will occasionally change Windows network settings back to their default settings. This can cause network printers to quit working. Follow the instructions below to adjust the Windows settings and get the network printer working again. These instructions are for Windows 10 computers.

1. Click the windows button on the bottom left corner of the screen or on the keyboard.
2. When the windows start menu is displayed, type the word **share**. You should see Manage Advanced Sharing Settings appear. Use the mouse and left click on Manage Advanced Sharing Settings.
3. When the Manage Advanced Sharing Setting screen is displayed, click on the down arrow next to All Networks and find the option to turn off password protected settings. Then, left click save changes.

Do this on the computer that has the printer connected and any computers that need to print to the remote printer.
